This course will focus on social media and the inherent dangers it can pose to teens. The course will discuss current trends in cyber bullying as seen by School Resource Officers. The course will allow the participant to teach a one hour presentation to students (6th to 12th grade)that will focus on the importance of maintaining a positive digital reputation and possible consequences both personal and legal if they engage in cyber bullying. Secondly, the course will also allow the student to teach a 3 hour course to parents that will complement the student presentation. The parent presentation will outline the dangers and current trends in cyber bullying, the emotional toll it takes on children and then instruct them on how to effectively parent their children in the world of social media.
